ANNOUNCEMENT OF ITS PG TRAINEE GRANT 2025 - 2026

Indian Thyroid Society (ITS) is inviting applications from DM/DNB Postgraduate trainees in Endocrinology, MCh trainees in Endocrine surgery & MD/DNB trainees in Nuclear Medicine for research studies focused on thyroid and related disorders in the Indian context. An independent review committee appointed by the executive committee will review the grant applications and the final sanctioned amount will be at discretion of the scientific committee of the Indian Thyroid society. Applicants should note that the Research project Guide should be a member of Indian Thyroid society.

Who are eligible to apply?

- (1) DM/DNB Postgraduate trainees in Endocrinology
- (2) MCh trainees in Endocrine Surgery
- (3) MD/DNB trainees in Nuclear Medicine

Mandatory requirements

- (1) Research project guide should be a member of Indian Thyroid Society.
 - (2) Study protocol should be cleared by local Ethics Committee before disbursement of grant.
 - (3) The Principal Investigators are required to submit six monthly progress reports and final report along with utilizations in the prescribed formats
 - (4) It is desirable that any publications arising in part or full from the funded study should be published in Thyroid Research and Practice.
 - (5) If the publication is in any other journal, authors should acknowledge the support by ITS.
- Number of Grants Available - 5
 - Amount available - Up to Rupees 2 lakh each (at the discretion of Research committee)
 - Last date of submission of project- January 20th 2026
 - Final decision on grant approval - February 15th 2026
 - Dispersal of funds- March 15th 2026
